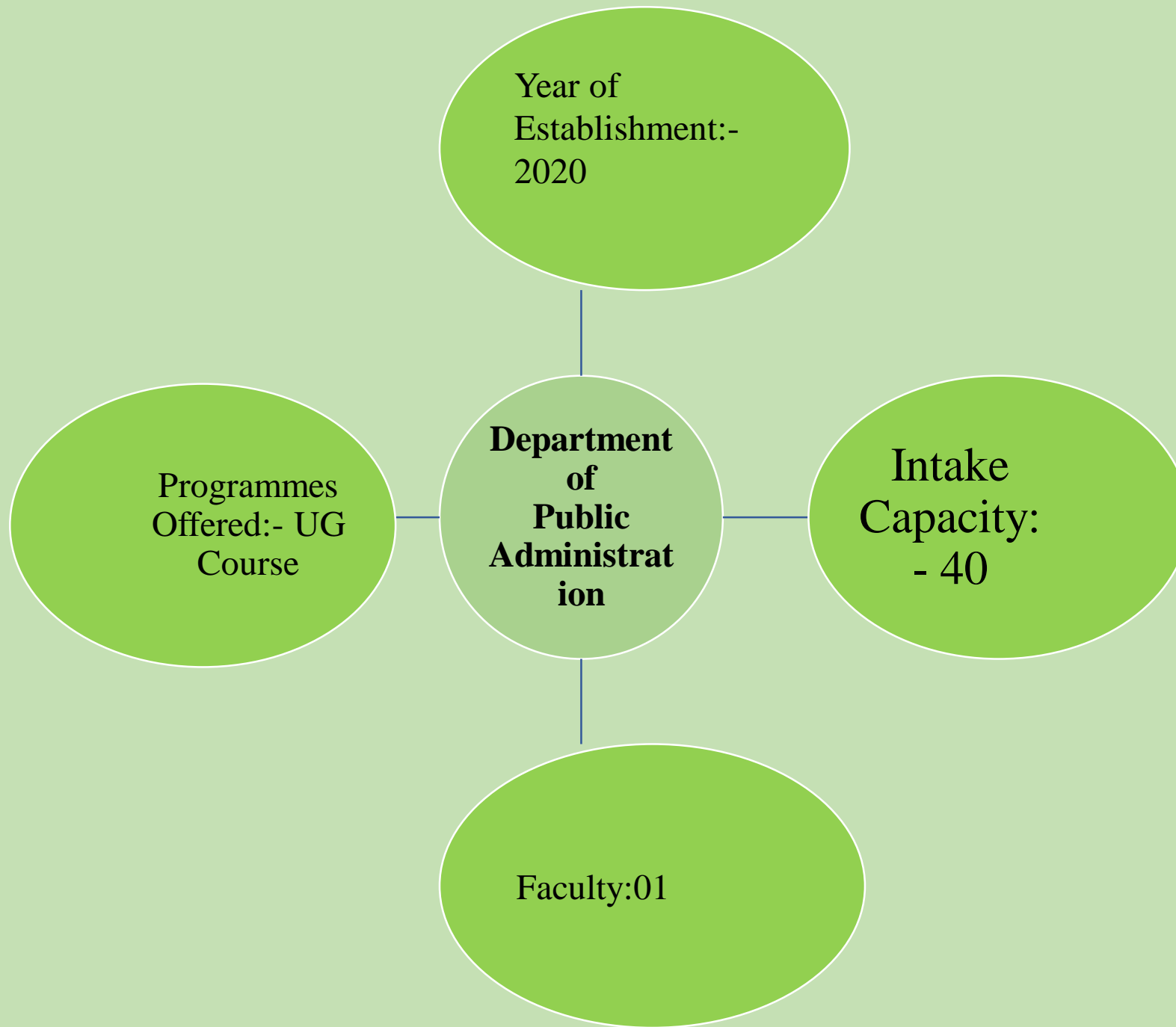

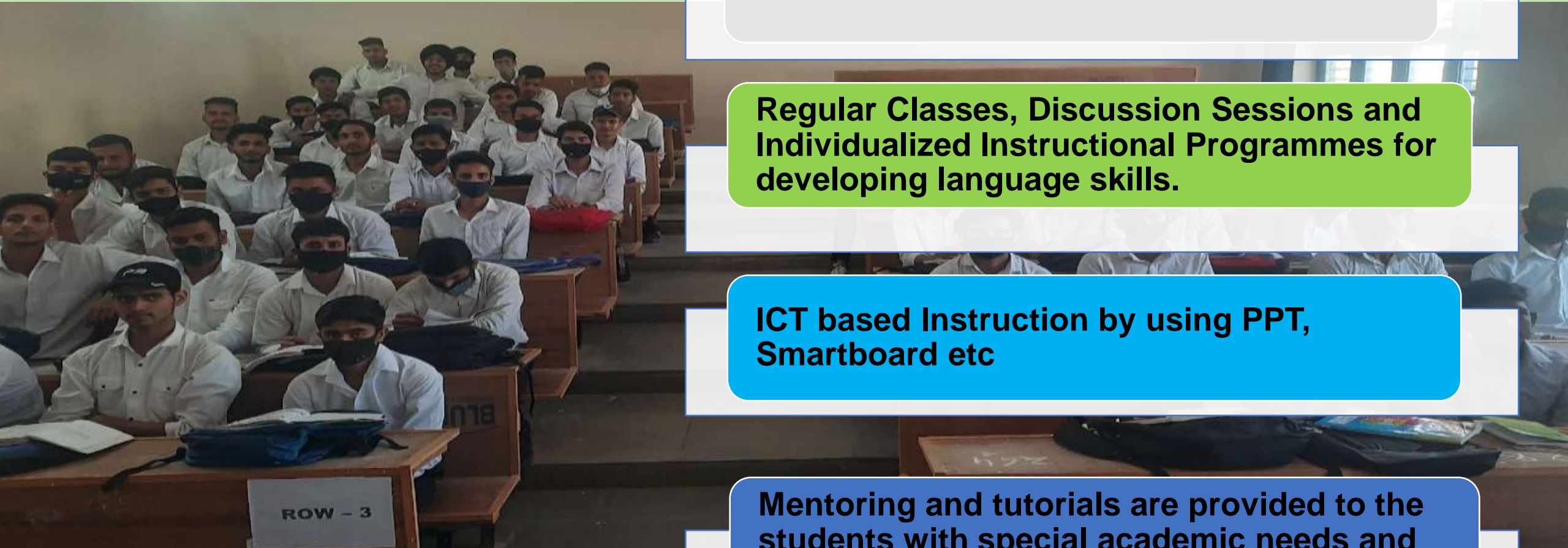

Mode of Assessment

- Under the Semester system, introduced by the University of Jammu, the 3 year B.A Degree Programme spreads over 6 semesters, with 2 semesters in each year.
- The evaluation of each course comprises of two parts: Internal or In Semester Assessment (IA) and External or End-Semester Assessment (EA).
- Internal Assessment is done by College itself whereas external examination is conducted by the University. Each theory paper consists of 100 marks, 20% of which has been reserved for internal assessment and 80% for External Examination to be conducted by the University. However students have to maintain a minimum of 75% attendance mark to be eligible for the term end examination.
