### Mode of Assessment

Under the Semester system, introduced by the University of Jammu, the 3 year B.A Degree Programme spreads over 6 semesters, with 2 semesters in each year. The evaluation of each course comprises of two parts: Internal or In Semester Assessment (IA) and External or End-Semester Assessment (EA). Internal Assessment is done by College itself whereas external examination is conducted by the University. Each theory paper consists of 100 marks, 20% of which has been reserved for internal assessment and 80% for External Examination to be conducted by the University. However students have to maintain a minimum of 75% attendance mark to be eligible for the term end examination.

### SWOC/SWOT ANALYSIS

#### Departmental Strengths:-

1. Department has well qualified and experienced permanent faculty.
2. Mechanism is available for direct mentoring of students by faculty, interacting with students, and directing them to upgrade their skills.
3. Popularity of subject among the learners due to its multidisciplinary content which results in enrolment beyond intake capacity.
4. Adequate number of textbooks, journals and reference books in the library.

**Departmental Weakness:**

1. Inadequate number of sanctioned posts.
2. Insufficient Infrastructure in term of departmental block and library.
3. Lack of Community involvement.
4. Faculty work load and pupil teacher ratio is high.
5. Limited research programme.

**Departmental Opportunities:-**

1. Scope for the development of interdisciplinary projects useful for society.
2. Greater chances of consultancy and extension.
3. Department can emerge as centre of excellence in education by starting a four year integrated teacher education programme.

**Departmental Challenges:-**

1. Development of advanced teaching & learning methodologies and evolution, personal interaction by developing smart classrooms and mechanism for effective evaluation.
2. Within the existing structure the department finds it difficult to respond to varied needs of its students coming from different socio-economic, educational and cultural background.
