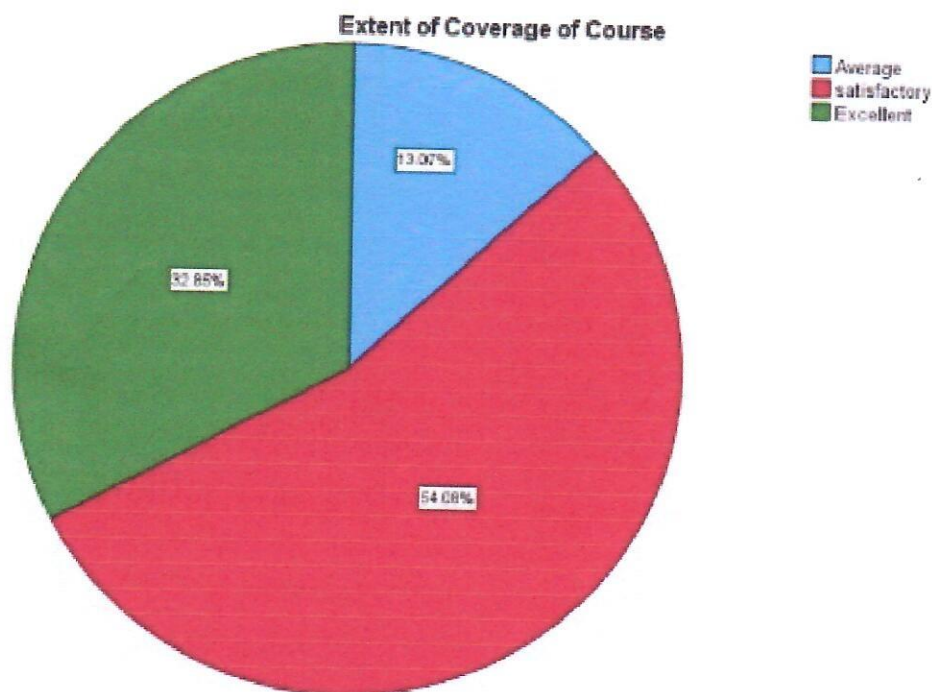
STUDENT FEEDBACK ANALYSIS & ACTION TAKEN REPORT

- Extent of coverage of the Course in the class

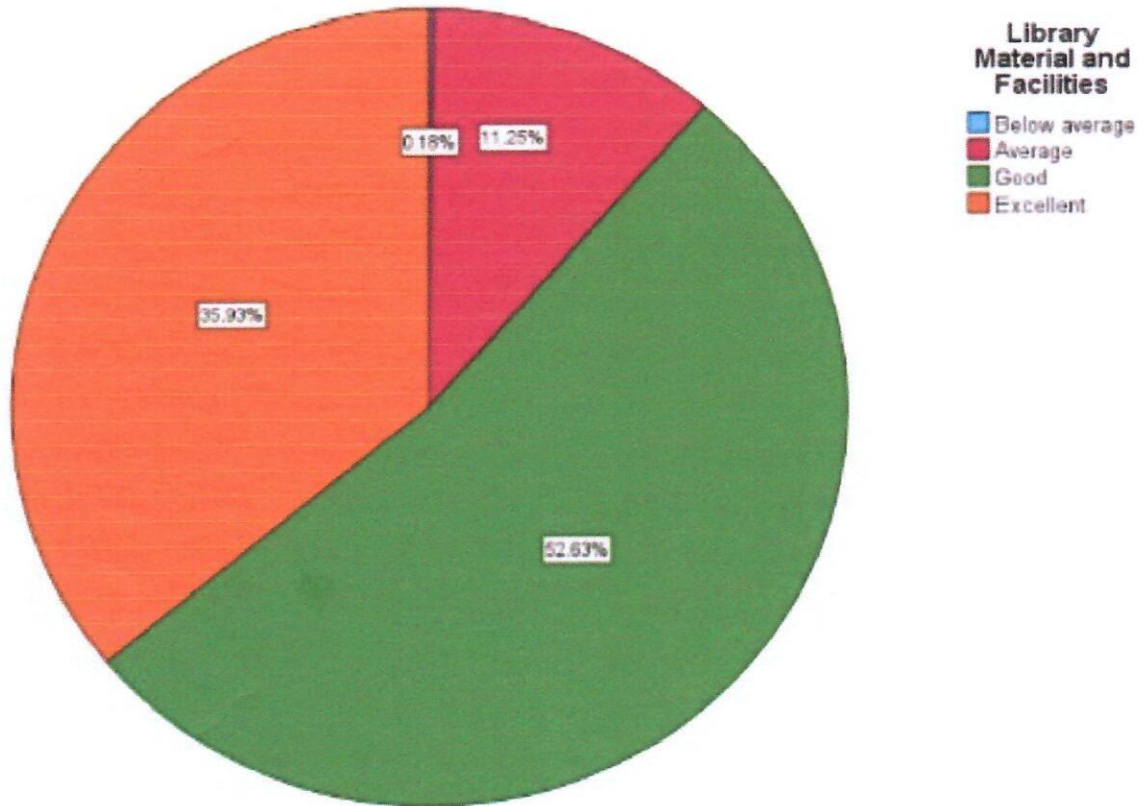


Analysis & Action Taken

- Availability of Library material & facilities for the course



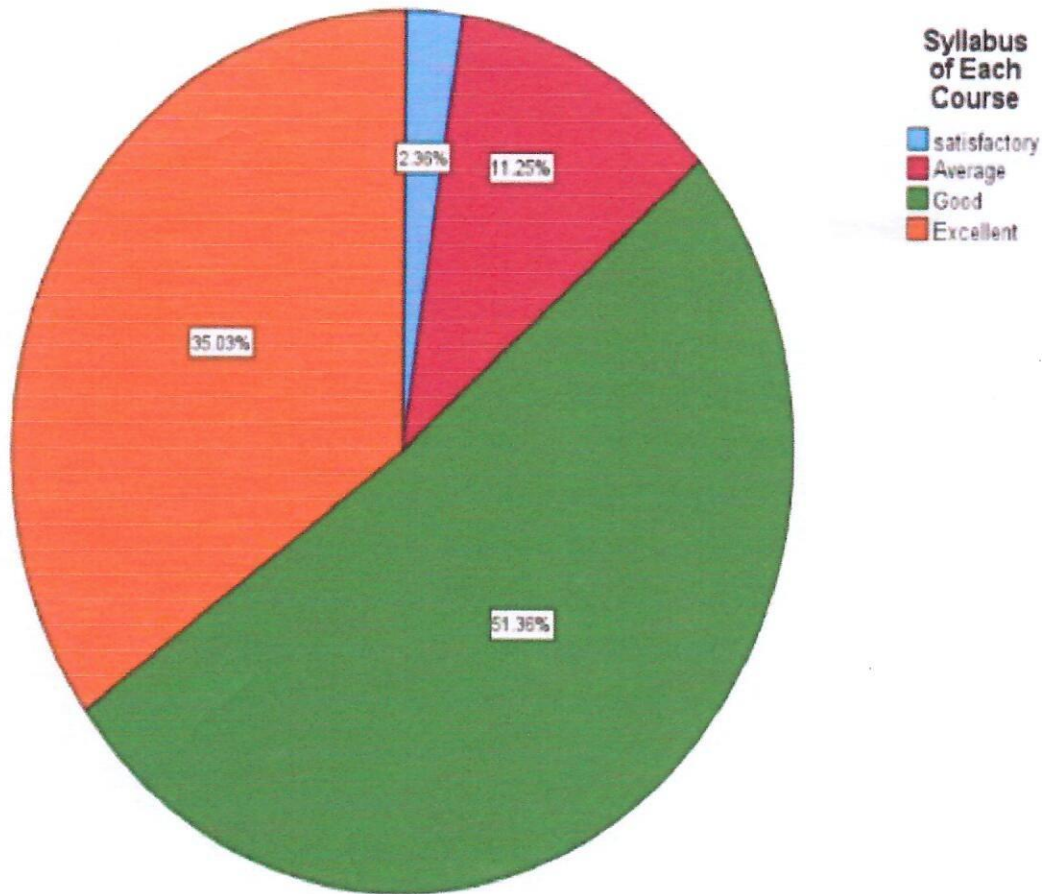
Analysis & Action Taken

Depth of Course Content and its applicability/relevance to real life situations

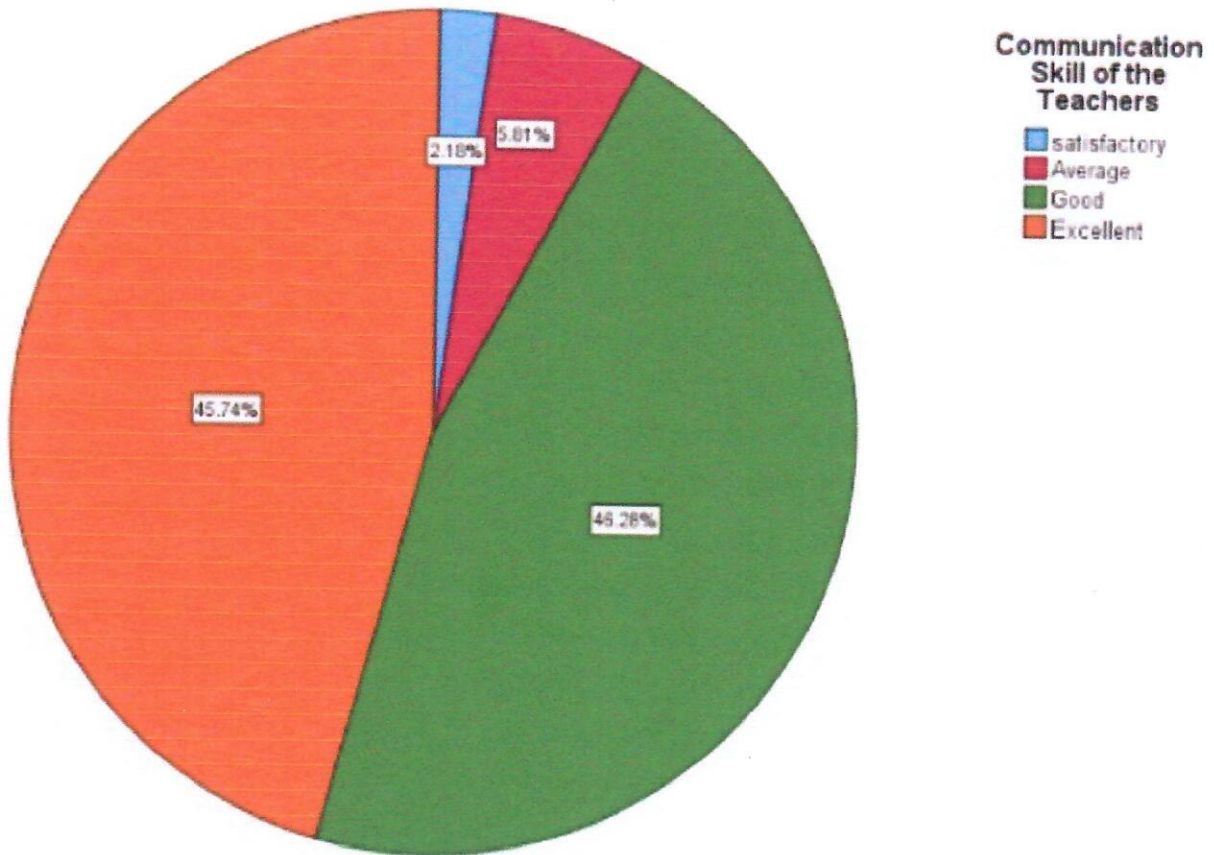


Analysis & Action Taken

Communication skill of the Teacher



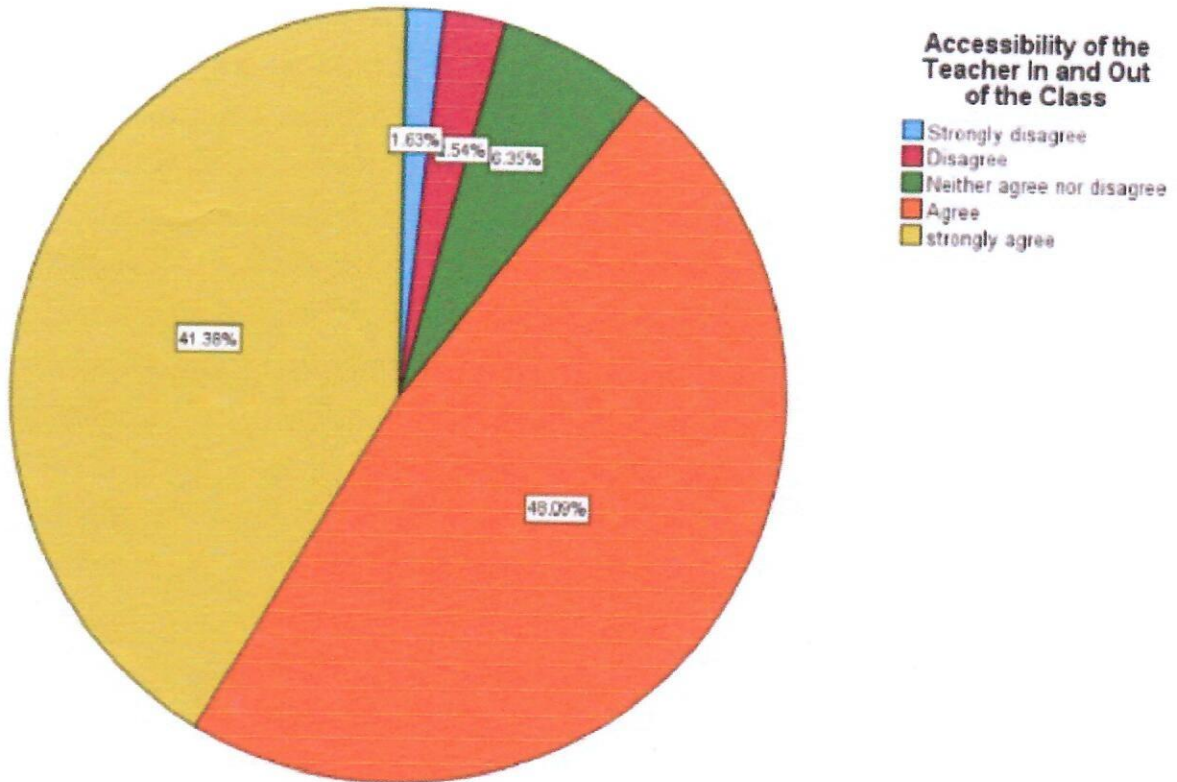
Analysis & Action Taken
