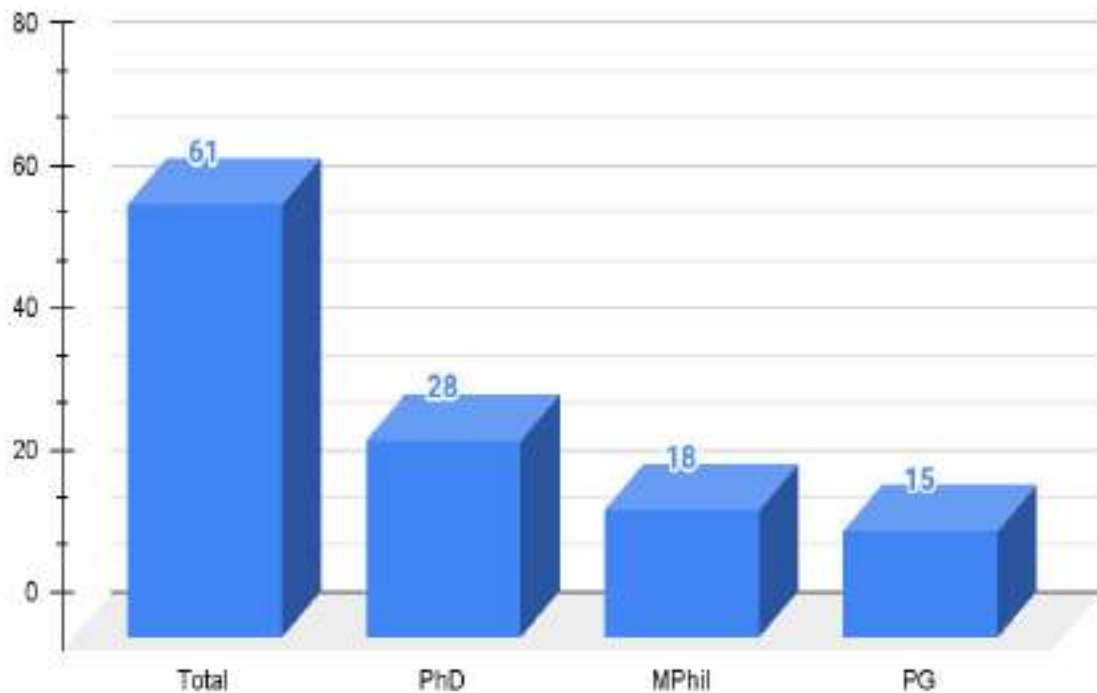

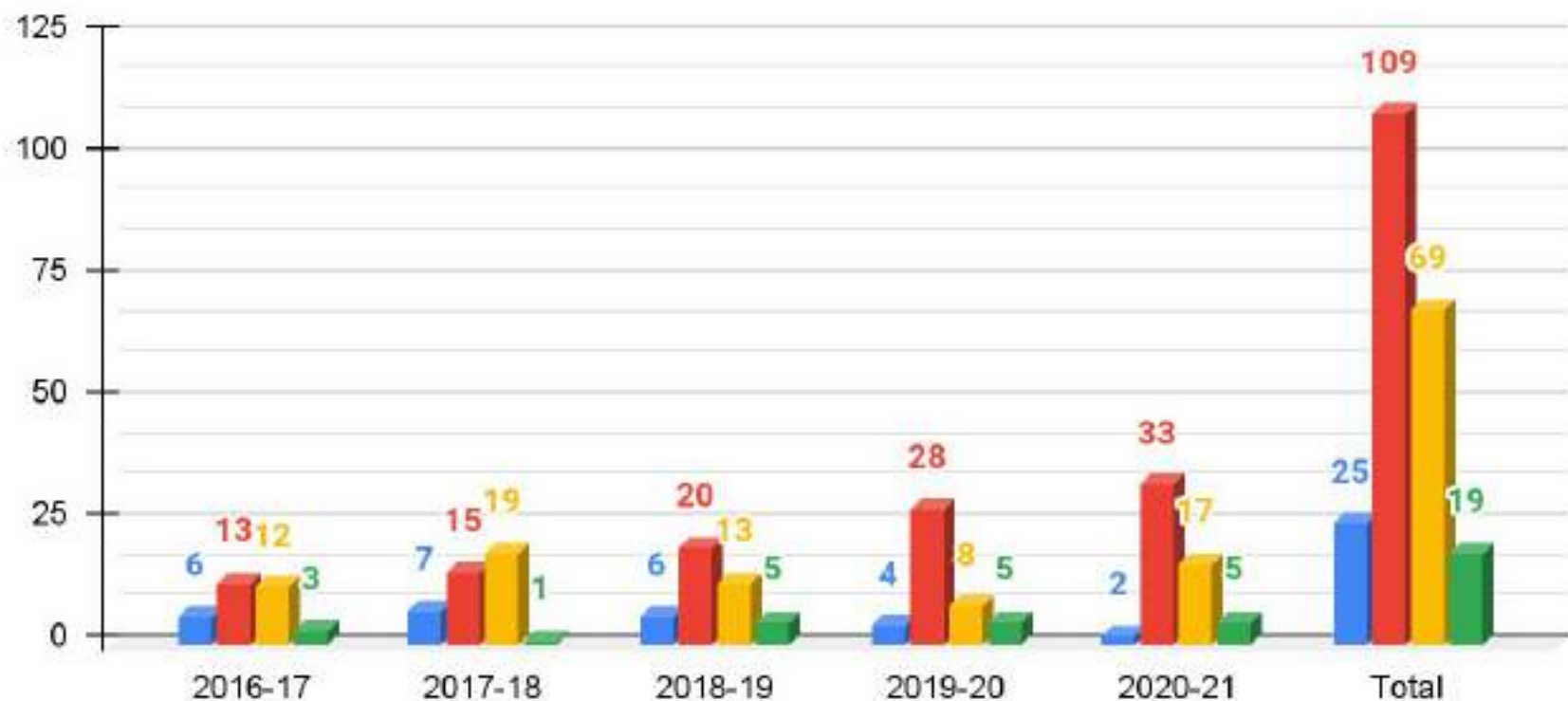

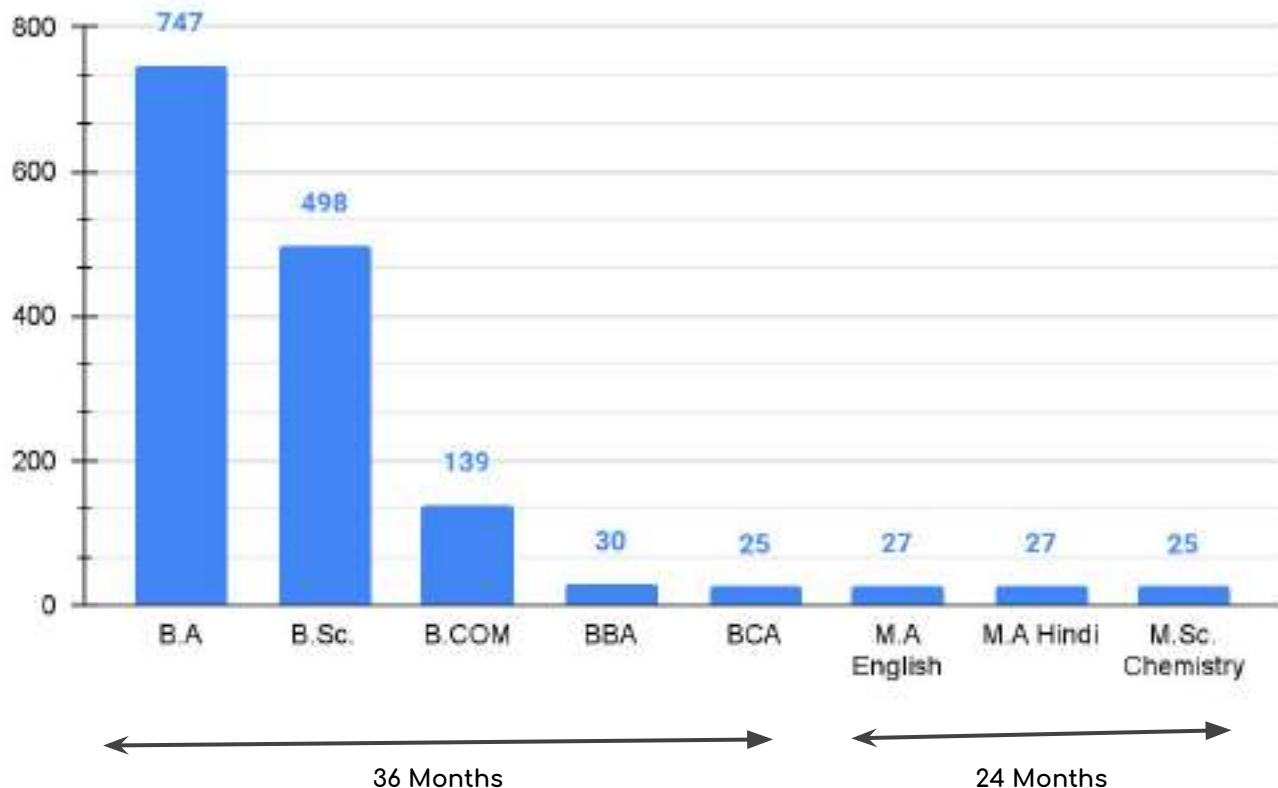

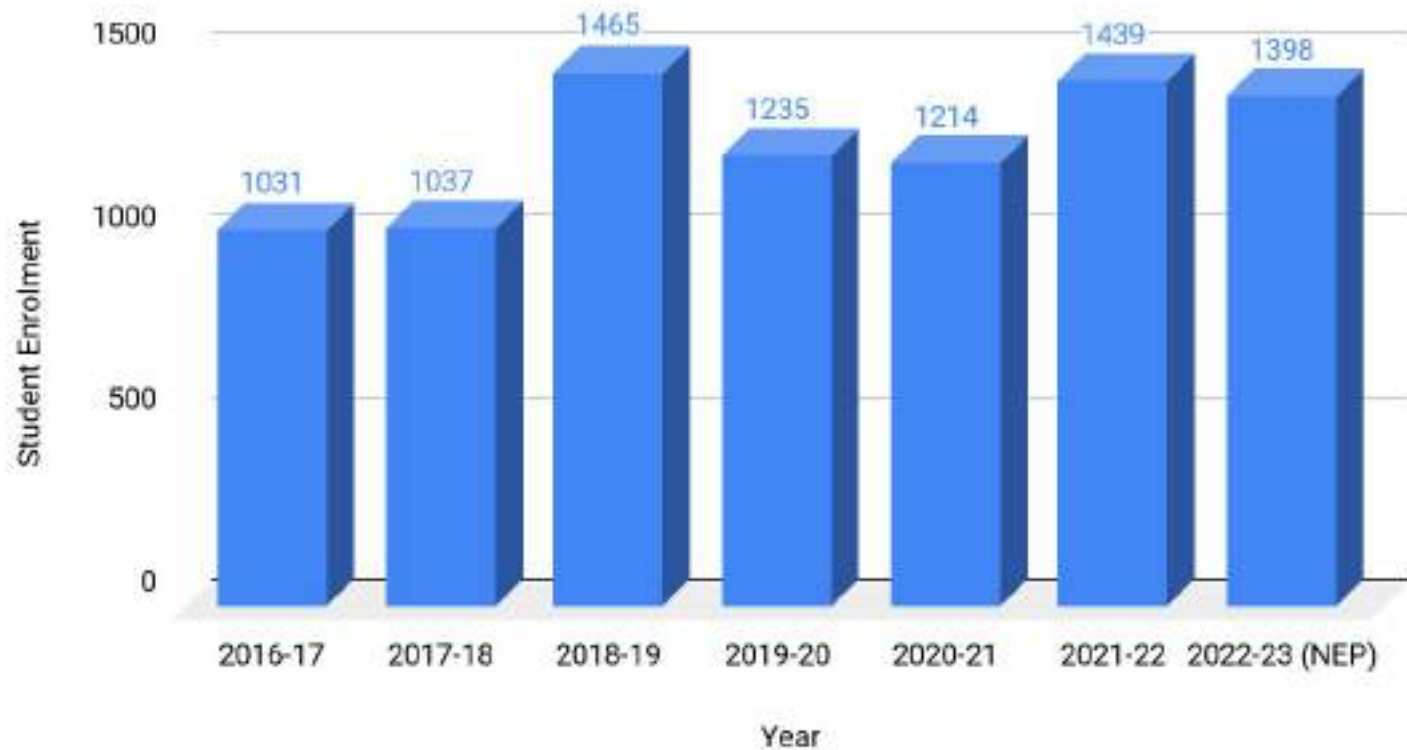

Year Wise Student Enrolment

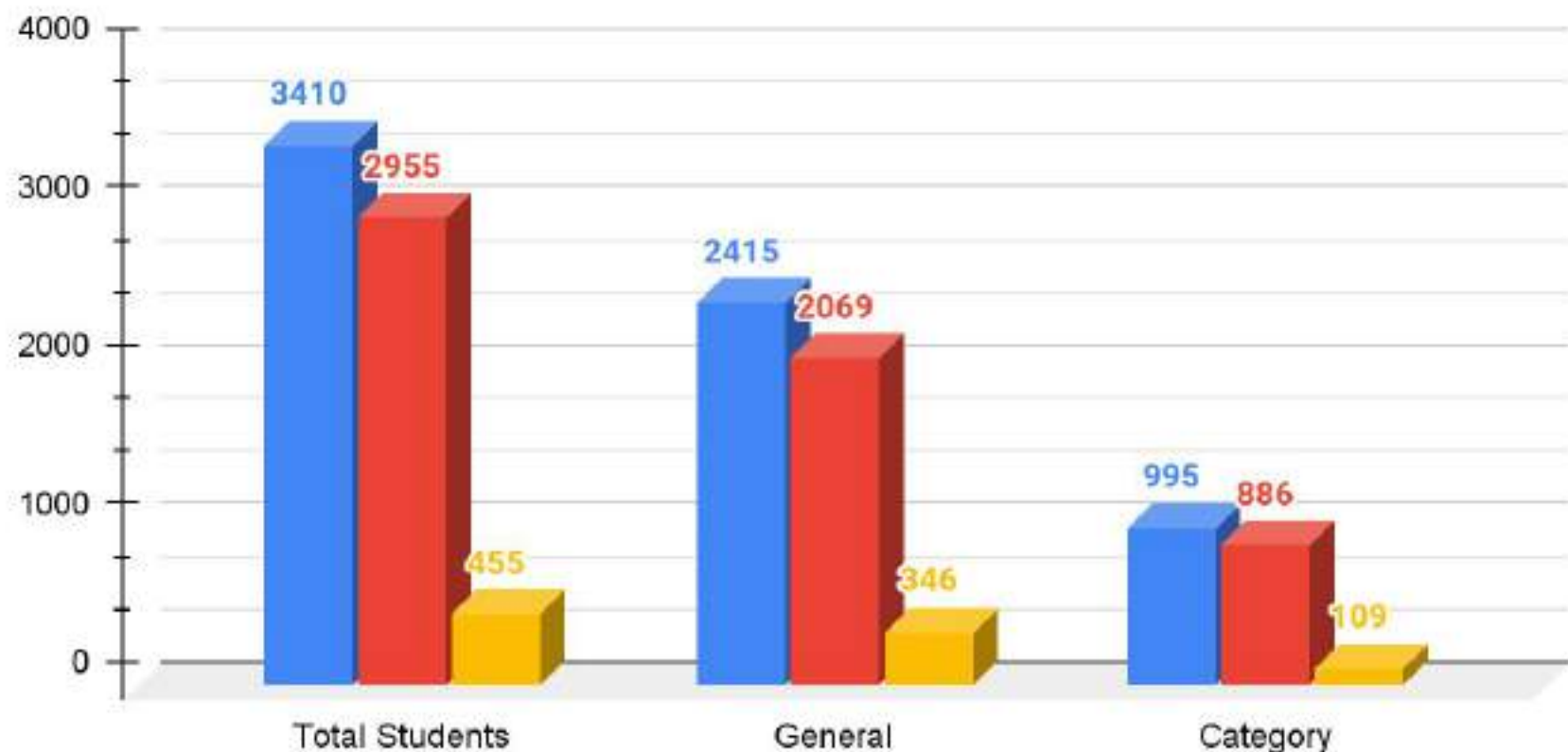


Year wise Enrolment for 1st Semester



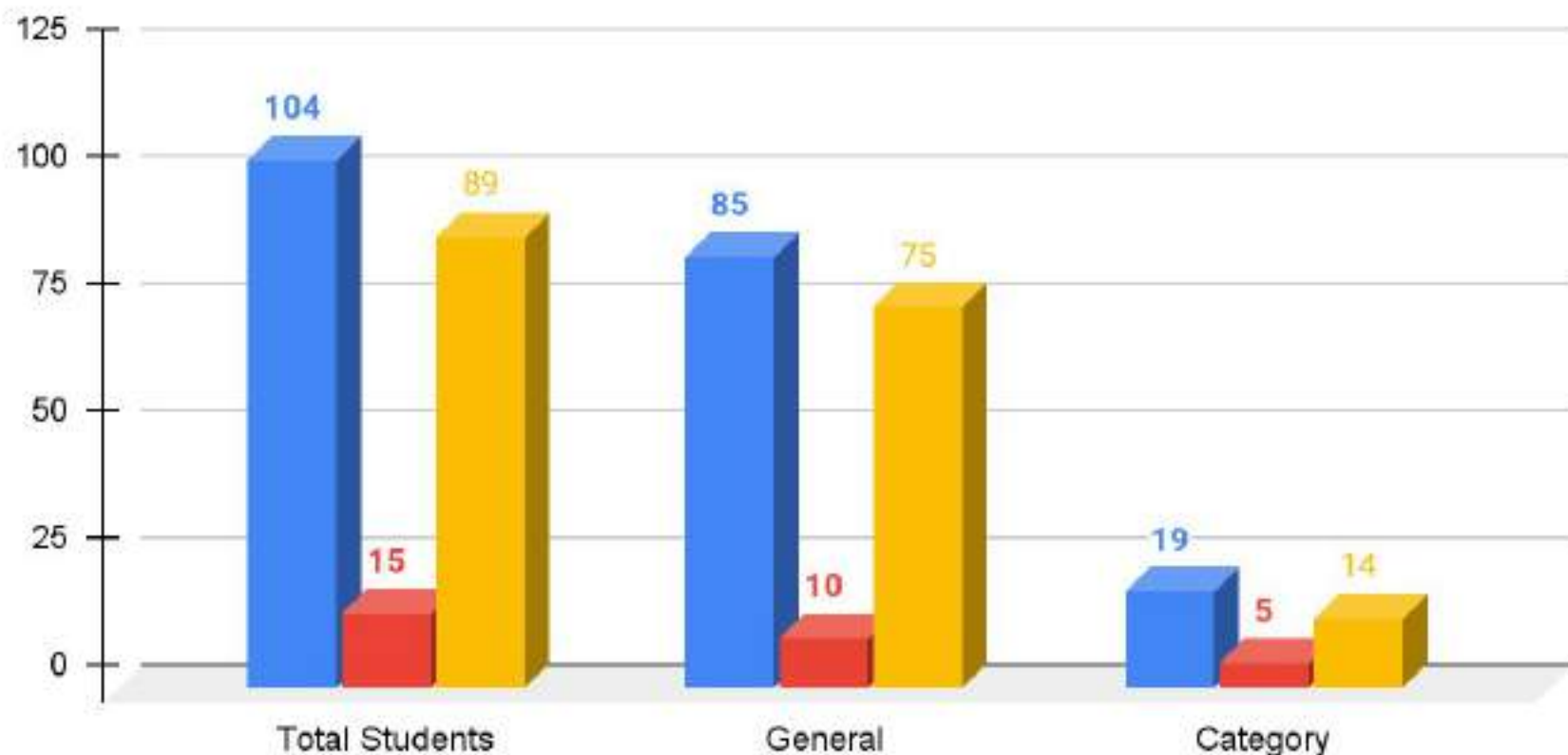
Category wise Undergraduate Student enrolment 2021-22

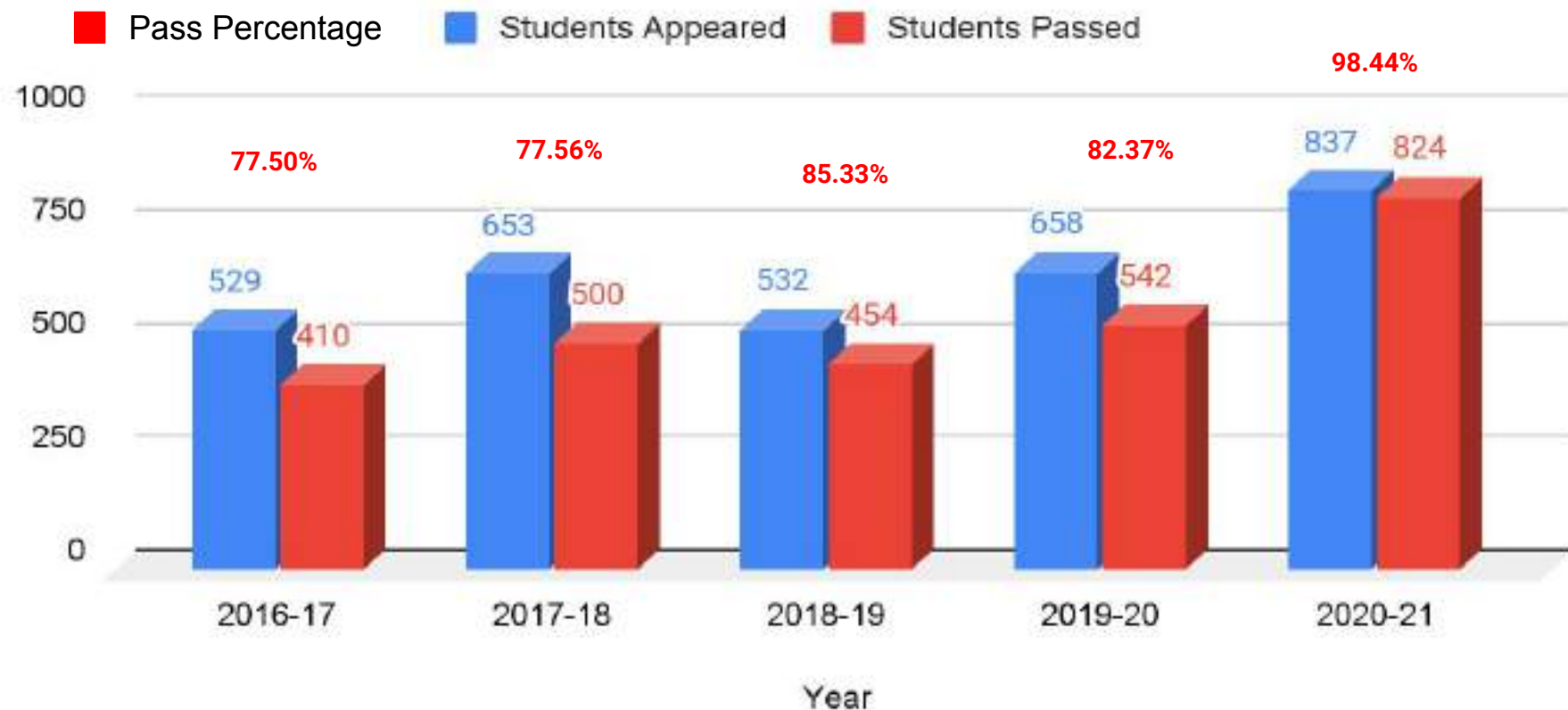
Category Wise Postgraduate Student Enrolment
