DOGRI CONCLUDED AT GDC UDHAMPUR**

30-06-2017 One Week Workshop organized by the Commission for Scientific and Technical Terminology, MHRD, Govt. of India in collaboration with Department of Botany Govt. Degree College Udhampur for coinage of fundamental glossary of Botany in Dogri Language concluded today in which more than 900 scientific and technical terms of the Botany in Dogri were coined and evolved by the experts who participated in the said workshop. Technical words like **Spermocarp-नर्कदफ्लिका**, **Spermogonium-नर्कनुधानी**, **Stele-कठाल**, **Spindle-त्रोकली**, **Subterminal-सिखार्तालू**, **Sympodial-टाहलतनोड़ी**, **Telophase-बंड-अंतवस्था**, **Transduction-विसनुबंसीरलान** etc found their Dogri Equivalents. It was commission's fourth meeting for the business of evolving and coining Dogri Equivalents of the technical terms of Botany. The Project was jointing taken up jointly by the Department of Botany, University of Jammu and Department of Botany, Govt. Degree College Udhampur in 2014. Dr. Dharmender Kumar, Assistant Director and Controlling Officer CSTT New Delhi informed during his concluding remarks that commission intends to establish a Board for the development of knowledge on physical sciences in Dogri Language in the region after developing fundamental glossaries of other subjects which will go long way in developing and disseminating the knowledge to the society in general and students community in their mother tongue.
